Camping Policies

- RV Vehicles Allowed: Motor homes, RVs, Travel Trailers, Fifth-Wheels, Pop-up Campers, and Buses converted to RVs.
- Tow Vehicles Allowed: Any street legal vehicle which can be driven in and out of the facility.
- RV Vehicle Pass must be placed against the front windshield or on entry door window of the RV, Tow Vehicle Pass must be placed against the front windshield of the Tow Vehicle.
- The resale of Vehicle/Admission RV Passes and RV Upgrade Admissions is strictly prohibited. Only those with the proper passes are allowed entry. There are no exceptions.
- Tent camping is allowed with 1 (one) vehicle per 20' x 60' space.
- Quiet time will be enforced from 11pm to 6am.
- No pools.
- Advertisements of products or services are not permitted on property. Race or Driver related items are excluded.
- RV spaces are allowed only 1 (one) tow vehicle per space. All driven motor homes, towable campers
 or vehicles must fit within the 20' x 60' space for the infield.
- Fire lanes must be open at all times. Vehicles blocking lanes will be towed.
- No tractor trailers, car trailers, box rental or cargo utility trucks allowed.
- One (1) 10' x 10' EZ Up Canopy is allowed per space, provided it fits within the 20' x 60' space and does not exceed the height limit of 14'.
- Platforms more than one foot above the manufacturer's roofline of any RV are not permitted.
- Ladders and platforms must be secured to the RV.
- Scaffolds, temporary canopies, loose lumber and portable/temporary spectator stands will not be permitted.
- Safety railing is recommended and allowed provided that the railing does not pose a safety threat to you or others and does not obstruct the view of others.
- State and county health department rules must be obeyed. Dumping waste water onto the ground or into the holes on facility property is not permitted. Dumping and water service will be available for an additional cost.
- The speed limit on Dirt Oval 66 property is 5mph. All motor vehicle operators must have a valid state driver's license.
- Personal golf carts, scooters, ATV's or other motorized units allowed on Dirt Oval 66 property but must be turned off completely, 30 minutes post event. NO motorized units allowed after 30 minutes post event. Dirt Oval will strongly enforce this.
- Bicycles are permitted.
- Fireworks, water guns and balloon launchers, spotlights, laser pointers or other items deemed dangerous are not permitted.
- External sound systems are not permitted. Internal sound system must be kept at a reasonable sound level.
- Pets are welcome.
- All pets must be kept on a handheld leash that is 6 feet or shorter or confined in the interior of the owner's personal recreational vehicle. For pop-ups and tents, pets must be secured in a container, such as a portable cage or kennel.

- Guests with pets may take their dogs to play in designated pet play areas or walk their pet in the camping areas. Pet owners are required to pick up after their pets and properly dispose of waste.
- Pets that interfere with the quality of the guest experience at Dirt Oval 66 campground areas in any way (such as aggression, noise, waste, etc.) or generate a legitimate complaint to management will result in the pet owner being required to discontinue the pet's inappropriate behavior, remove the pet to an off-site kennel or leave the campsite.
- Pet owners are responsible for any personal injury or property damage caused by their pet.
- Open and/or wood fires are permitted only with metal ring. Contained barbecue and camping stoves will be permitted. Please bring one (1) gallon of water to extinguish coals at the conclusion of each barbeque.
- Trash must be placed in provided receptacles.
- Illegal activities or activities that violate local laws an RV rules are not permitted. Lewd behavior offensive signs, public intoxication and/or profanity will not be tolerated. Violators will be subject to arrest and/or removal from the facility.
- Dirt Oval 66 reserves the right to amend or implement rules at any time. All rules and regulations will be strictly enforced. Breach of these rules or regulations should be reported to security.
- Violators will be subject to removal from the facility.
