



## 2018 GENERAL INFORMATION PACKET

Please text 33222 the word SCOUTS for all information for this weekend.

- Scout Night arrival will begin Friday, August 24<sup>th</sup> at 6:00pm. Please enter at Gate 11 off of Route 53. Upon entering, look for the Scout Activities Signage. You will use the right lane as entering, and the camping area is on your right. Please follow appropriate signs. You will be directed to your camping site. You may bring your vehicles on the grass to your camping site to unload. After unloading, you will need to move your vehicle to the parking lot which will be just across the way. Personal vehicles will not be allowed in the "camping area".
- PARKING/ARRIVAL INFO: When arriving FRIDAY you will use GATE 11. Anytime PRIOR to 3pm on Saturday, you will use GATE 11. After 4pm on Saturday, GATE 13. If Troops arrive Friday evening, or anytime Saturday before 4pm, you will not be charged for parking. Should Troops arrive after 4pm and only be attending our Meet & Greet and Race, each car is charged our standard \$5 for parking upon entrance through gate 13.
- If Troops are camping on Saturday night, everything and everyone must be packed up and ready for your exit by 10:00am Sunday morning. Upon exiting, you will use gate 11.
- All Troops will have access to the dirt tracks bathroom facilities. Running water is available in the bathroom. All bathroom facilities will open at 6am on Saturday morning. Port A Johns will be provided for all Friday night camping.
- No meals will be provided to the Troops by Dirt Oval66. Troops are welcome to bring whatever supplies they need to cook their meals (grills, tables, etc). The track concessions will be open Saturday at 4pm, if Troops choose to eat a meal at the track.

- A security guard will be on duty throughout the night Friday and Saturday night.
- Troops will be camping on the grass next to the track. Please be prepared and bring all supplies needed for your average camping trip. There are no power or water hookups. These are DRY camping areas only. Lighting will be provided.
- Troops are not required to participate in all of the activities and can pick and choose which activities they wish to participate in. If you have not done so, please fill this information out online @ <https://www.dirtoval66.com/fan-info/scout-night-registration/> so that #teamdirt can have appropriate number of supplies on hand.
- Troops are invited to participate in our opening ceremonies on Saturday night. This is simply the Introduction to our Main Event. Opening ceremonies begin at 7pm. We ask the Troops to wear their uniforms and to bring their flags for the ceremonies. At this time is when all Troops will be announced. SCOUT TROOP 324 will be presenting our flags for Color Guard & SCOUT TROOP 216 Brian Brusak will be singing our National Anthem.
- Most of the activities will be taken place on our dirt track and surrounding facilities, so please dress accordingly.
- Seating for Saturday's race is general admission. Troops are allowed to reserve seats with blankets on Saturday AFTER 4pm to help ensure they sit together. Please be advised that because our track is general admission seating, Dirt Oval is not responsible for saving seats, or for seats that were saved and moved by other attendees.
- We will distribute several black garbage bags per troop. Please be sure to bag your garbage and put out for pick up at Saturday Morning and Sunday Morning. It is a huge help to our staff which will also be attending to our main event.
- The FLAGSTAND is a general meeting area that we will refer to all weekend. This is located in the central area of our front grandstands. Please be prompt.

**6:00pm** – Scout Night – Night 1 Arrival begins! ALL Troops will enter at Gate 11 off of Route 53. Please use right lane and follow SCOUT signage. Upon arrival, you will

be directed to the camp grounds for set up. You may bring your vehicle to your camping spot for set up but will then need to move your vehicle to our parking lot across the way. You will see a white trailer that we will use for SCOUT INFO for the weekend. You will need to check-in at the trailer. If your Troop has chosen the Will Call option, we will have them there for you. If you used the print at home option, please have your tickets ready. #Team Dirt staff will be on hand to answer any questions. Please be prepared for each and every person to sign our insurance waiver. (This may be a timely task but a very important one. Thank you for your patience and understanding.)

**Dusk** – Dirt Oval 66 will provide a campfire for all Troops in a central location to enjoy and socialize for the evening. Dirt Oval 66 will be providing S'Mores and all the supplies needed including bamboo sticks for roasting. Please bring your own chairs.
